For 57TH STREET ART FAIR - CHICAGO, you have been identified as the person, who promotes, organizes, or provides retail selling space for concessionaires or other types of sellers. When a vendor sells general merchandise to the public at fairs, art shows, festivals, flea markets, and other similar events, Illinois Sales Tax is due.

- 1) You are required to file a report with us for each vendor (whether selling as a business or as a hobby) at your event. The report must be filed within 10 days following the last day of your event and include the following information:
 - name of vendor's business
 - name of the person or persons engaged in the vendor's business
 - permanent address of the business
 - Illinois business tax (IBT) number of the business *Available*
 - dates and location of the event

- 2) Please distribute a copy of the enclosed Form IDOR-6-SETD, Special Event Tax Collection Report and Payment Coupon, to each vendor making sales at your special event. Each vendor is required to complete the report and pay Illinois Sales Tax from the special event.
